Anne shared that she attended a meeting this week and saw the summary data report that Ingham County put together. She was impressed and wondered if we could use their report as a template for our Eaton County summary report. Polly said she'd check with the Ingham Substance Abuse Prevention Coalition about the report and get back to the committee.

Scott reported that CMH is hosting an event, "Out of the Shadows" on October 18th. He passed around the flyer and said he'd send it to us electronically for further distribution.

Anne reported that BEHD purchased the SPSS software which is a data tool for statistical analysis of data. She will keep us posted how it can be of use to the data committee.

Polly reported that most of the data that was available to collect has been collected and entered into our updated Needs Assessment Workbook. The data that will go into the GIS meth and alcohol maps are on excel spread sheets and ready to be forwarded to Eric Daley from Information Systems.

Anne shared that BEHD is preparing for the new Behavior Risk Survey (BRS) for this year. The BRS is done every three years. The data should be complete and available to our data committee in Spring 2007.

Polly reported that all public school districts with the exception of Island City Academy have signed on for the PNA survey this fall.

Polly also reported that the PNA data for individual questions have been entered into the updated Needs Assessment Workbook. We will begin to review that data in the next months.

Polly reported that we received the funding for the Drug Free Communities Grant.

The remainder of our meeting, we completed the action plan for our 2006-07 Data Goal. Polly will type it up and Anne offered to present it at the next ECSAAG meeting.
