The plans for the Pre-SYNAR inspection blitz were unveiled to the subgroup and feedback was given. Chief Bill advised Nancy to get on the Police Chiefs' agenda, as soon as possible. He gave her the appropriate contact information. Nancy will contact Sheriff Raines and ask to attend one of the regular, monthly meetings of the police chiefs in Eaton County. At that meeting, she will request collaboration with all the local police departments and ECSD, so that all retail establishments in Eaton County can be checked, before the Federal SYNAR draw in July. Chief Bill was supportive and expected that local law enforcement officials would be interested in collaborating with this effort. Gail Duncan gave some information about the funding cycle for Eaton County United Way and discussion followed about funding for ECSAAG programs and activities. Nancy shared the information flyer for the Quit Session scheduled for 1-19-06 at EISD. She also informed the group of the upcoming SDFS grant planning workshop at EISD on April 26<sup>th</sup>.
